Scope: 45 Infusion Centers across 3 states

Specialties: Outpatient and Home Infusion

Objective: Achieve standardization across all locations, achieve real time visibility and tracking of equipment, and increase equipment uptime

Outcome:

- 600+ infusion pumps (single model) across all locations with Asset Tags
- Preventative Maintenance and Compliance Automation
- Centralized Rental Portal Deployed

Challenges:

- Inconsistent equipment across sites, complicating nurse training and patient throughput
- Over-rented or under-utilized inventory, driven by lack of centralized oversight
- 21 infusion pumps were unaccounted for — lost, misplaced, or incorrectly assigned across the network
- Rental terms varied by site, leading to unpredictable monthly spend
- Nursing and administrative teams spent hours coordinating rentals, tracking devices, and managing vendor communication

Results in 6 Months:
