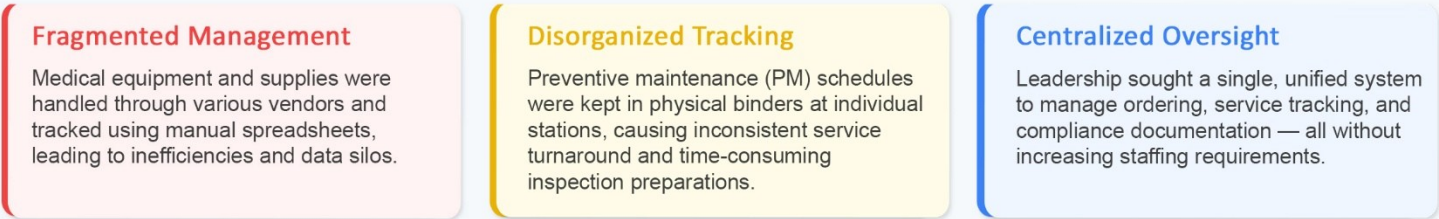

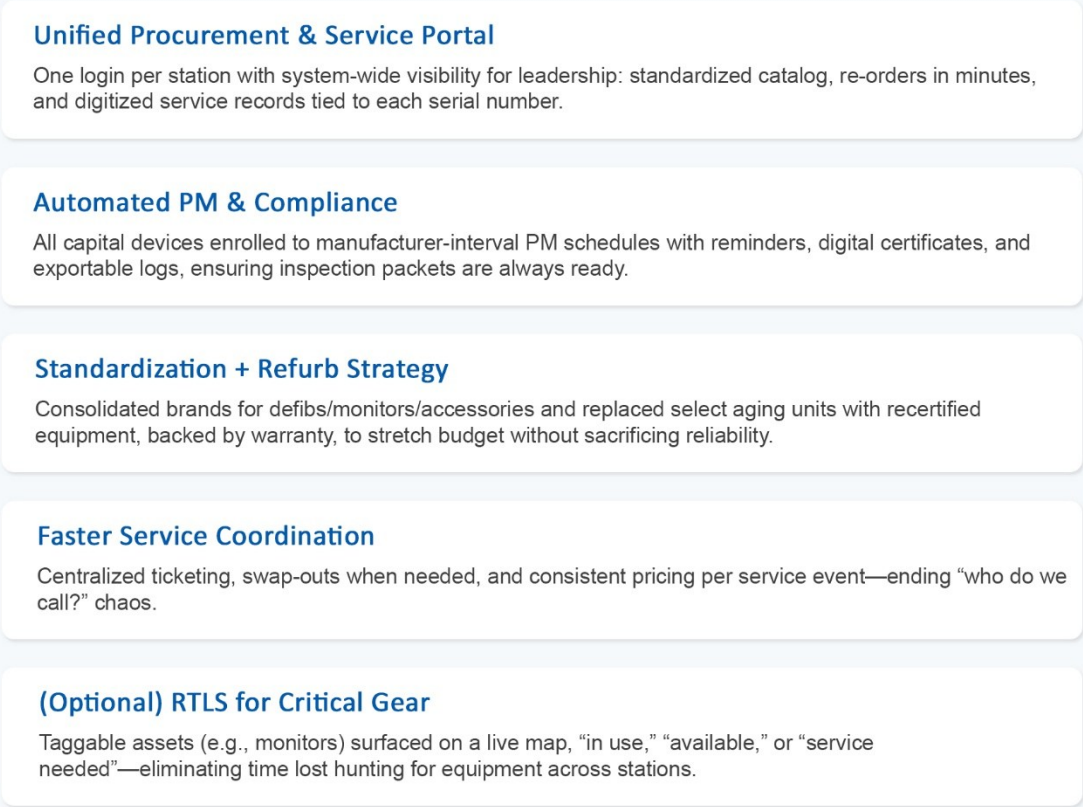
The Challenge

The AVIQ Solution

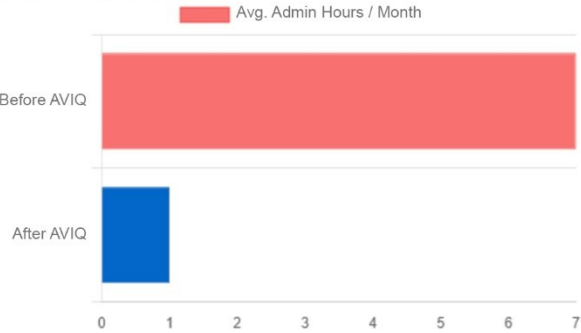
AVIQ deployed a “single-pane” portal and playbook tailored to Fire/EMS:



Immediate Impact: Results in 60 Days

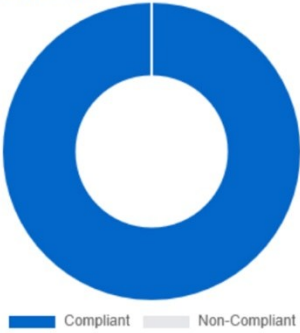
The deployment of the AVIQ portal and playbook yielded significant, measurable results within the first two months.

Administrative Time Slashed



Station-level admin time on vendor management and inspection prep dropped from an average of 7 hours/month to less than 1 hour.

100% PM Compliance Achieved



All enrolled capital devices jumped to 100% documented preventive maintenance compliance, completely ending inspection gaps.

Exceeding Cost Reduction Benchmarks



The department achieved 12-15% savings on targeted categories, exceeding AVIQ's typical 12%+ cost improvement benchmark.
